Abrakadoodle Art

At Abrakadoodle Art, we strive to spark your child's imagination while they think, create, discover, problem solve and build confidence.

Each child creates original artwork which reflects his or her own personal interpretation. We want imaginative and curious children to grow up into creative and inventive adults.

Blissful Movement Dance

Blissful Movement Dance Company will teach children the variety of dance genres such as jazz, ballet, hip hop, modern, contemporary, tumbling and tricks, and many more. At the end of each semester, Blissful Movement Dance Company will host a recital to showcase what students have learned!

Clubhouse

This is our Early Childhood general care class. In Clubhouse, students continue to learn while participating in themed weekly activities which include story and circle time, games, books, and more!

Gymnastics

Welcome to the Early Childhood Gymnastics Program! Join us in awe as we watch Rhythm and Dance Gymnastic Company turn our classroom into a mini–Viking Gymnastic studio! Students will learn foundational tumbling and gymnast skills using soft mats, balance beams and more!

Introduction to Chess

Unlock your child's potential early with our early childhood chess program! Our fun and interactive sessions introduce young minds to the timeless game of chess by fostering critical thinking, problem-solving skills, and strategic planning from an early age.

Led by experienced instructors, our program is tailored specifically for young learners, utilizing age-appropriate teaching methods and engaging activities to make learning chess a blast. Watch as your child develops concentration, patience, and confidence in a supportive and nurturing environment.

Introduction to LEGO Robotics

The Introduction to LEGO will give the students a space to use their imagination and bring their thoughts to life. The class will use Duplo Legos which are larger and easier to put together. The curriculum will include free build, category build, and lesson-based building. We cannot wait to see what our students create in this class!

Introduction to Mandarin

Introduction to Mandarin will allow students to begin their journey of learning the language with weekly lessons that include songs, shapes, numbers, sight words, seasons and more!

Introduction to Spanish

Junior Scientists

Led by our very own Village Teacher, students will experiment and explore the world of science! Your child will have opportunities to continue their journey into the world of STEAM with weekly hands-on experiments while learning what becoming a scientist is all about!

Karate

Parents can expect to see their child learn the importance of discipline, physical fitness and flexibility. All while developing an understanding of beginner karate stances, punches/strikes, kicks and more. Our program discourages youngsters from bullying fellow scholars, as they learn how to avoid being bullied through self-defense, focus, concentration, and humbleness. Students learn to exercise quietness in academic classrooms.

Nursery Rhymes and Problem Solving

Led by our very own Early Childhood teachers, Nursery Rhymes and Problem Solving is perfect for the curious pre-school student! Consider Humpty Dumpty...

Can you design a wall that Humpty would not fall from? Can you design and build a landing for him to safely fall? Each week students work in teams to solve a Nursery rhyme problem.

Soccer Tot Stars

Soccer Tot Stars is a high-quality sports program specifically designed to teach children aged 2 to 12 years old the structure of soccer through fun activities that develop each child's cognitive, gross motor, and social skills.

We teach children in a language they can understand, present skills in a way that captures their attention, but more importantly we make learning fun.

Sports Xplosion

Taught by our very own Viking Coach, students will be introduced to a variety of sports, emphasizing fun, teamwork, and foundational skills. By the end, participants will have experienced a broad range of activities that not only promote physical health but also cultivate an interest in sports. The sports will include, frisbee, kickball, obstacle course, basketball, sports movement, tee ball, corn hole, tennis, and so much more.

Tennis

Yoga

Yoga classes do not only help to develop our bodies physically but also improve our mental health. Our after-school yoga classes will help students develop and nurture flexibility, strength, and mental wellness.

Students will learn calming techniques that will teach them to overcome anxieties, anger, or stresses, that will enable them to build social and emotional skills while also developing their athleticism.
